Theme	<p>Video Games! Recreate something from a video game, or design a new kind of game inside Minecraft.</p> <p>Examples:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• pixel art of a character from another game• redstone music box that plays another games' theme• recreation of a location from another game• design of a new minigame like boat racing or Spleef
Submission	<p>Each submission must include either:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">a 1-4 screenshots and a note on what was built and why.a world file and a note on how to play it. <p>The form can be found at tasgamemakers.com/mc2026 along with more information about how to export worlds or how to take and where to find Minecraft screenshots.</p>
Duration	<p>The competition is open for submissions from February 18. The entry form will close at 11:59pm on April 10, 2026.</p>
Eligibility	<p>Submissions should be made by groups of Tasmania-based students up to Grade 12. Groups can span classes, schools, or age groups but should have no more than 5 members. Home or distance education students are welcome. Groups may receive help from adults like teachers or guardians, but this should not contribute significantly to the output.</p> <p>To ensure compatibility and comparability, submissions should use a recent version of Minecraft (version 1.19 or later) in any edition (Bedrock, Java, Education) with no additional mods or custom textures.</p> <p>Though they may be inspired by other gaming media that is not PG-13, submitted builds and screenshots should remain strictly suitable for a PG-13 audience - no harsh language, sexual themes, or intense violence.</p>
Outcome	<p>Submissions will be reviewed by local judges from across Minecraft and game development. All submissions will receive feedback/compliments. Those who conform to the content guidelines and are appropriate to showcase at the Level Up Tasmania event will be notified of this. The top 3 entries will also be contacted to receive their prize of \$100 credit for Area 52, a gaming culture shop in Hobart.</p>
